Hugh and brother Gordon Neill's main profession was as opticians and importers of optical and scientific instruments and photographic materials. They went into partnership in mid-1921 and their premises were located on George Street, Dunedin. The Neill brothers were the official photographers of the New Zealand and South Sea International Exhibition held in Dunedin in 1925-26.

This document is the result of contributions made by many of our Society's members with notable work done by Paul Ferris, William Main and Steve McLachlan.
